

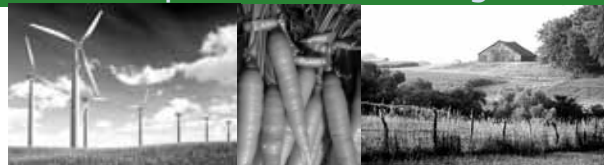
Help Iowa Shares positively change the community.
